# Home-schooling:

For families that may want to home-school their child, please complete OCISS Form 4140, Exceptions to Compulsory Attendance, and submit the form to the governing board of Hālau Lōkahi. Families that wish to have their students participate in the Statewide Testing Program will need to contact their DOE Home School in order to participate in testing.

# Other Public Charter Schools:

Information on the admissions cycles at the Hawaiian-focused charter schools:

- Hakipuu Learning Center: The school serves grades 4-12 and is accepting applications through May 31, 2015.
- Halau Ku Mana: The admissions lottery was held on April 2, 2015. The school will still accept
  applications to fill any remaining seats; if no seats are available, applicants will be put on a wait list.
- Ka Waihona o ka Na'auao Public Charter School: Please contact the school, if interested in applying. The school is currently in the process of determining how many openings per grade level are available.

- Kamaile Academy: The school is a conversion school for grades K-6; if you live in the geographic area that the school serves, your child will be able to attend the school. For those who live outside the school's service area, you will need to submit a geographic exception form. For grades 7-12, the school has informed us that there are no openings for grade 7. For grades 8-12, the school is accepting applications.
- Malama Honua Public Charter School: The school has openings only for Kindergarten; the school will accept applications for grades 1-3, however applicants will be placed on a wait list.
