

# Ka ‘Umeke Kā‘eo School Models SY 2020-2021

## KEY POINTS:

- The school week will consist of Instructional days on P1-P2 and P4-P5 (Monday-Tuesday and Thursday-Friday) with Wednesday being an independent online/pāhana instructional day (no zooms) to allow for deep cleaning and sanitization, school planning and preparation, and professional development.
- Haumāna bell schedule for the year is from 8:05-2:15.
- Haumāna can arrive at school NO EARLIER than 7:30 am to ensure wellness checks are done with ‘ohana.
- Haumāna first day of school is P1- 8/17/2020.

Although we will be following the State’s and Governor’s actions in regards to the Reopening phases, **Ka ‘Umeke will also be closely monitoring the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic within the state and our own community and may choose to make the move to more stricter models/phases (ie. from ACT WITH CARE to SAFER AT HOME) as necessary based off of current state/county/community data.***
