# FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE KANU O KA 'ĀINA NEW CENTURY PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL JULY 01, 2017 3.0 CHARTER CONTRACT

### I. Background

This Amendment to the July 01, 2017 3.0 Charter Contract (the "Amendment") dated as of July 01, 2021 (the "Effective Date"), is by and between the State Public Charter School Commission previously located at 1111 Bishop Street, Suite 516, Honolulu, Hawaii, 96813 (the "Commission"), and KANU O KA 'ĀINA NEW CENTURY PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL, whose mailing address is 64-1043 Hiiaka Street, Kamuela, Hawaii 96743, (the "School"), (collectively the "Parties").

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a 3.0 Charter Contract effective July 01, 2017 (the "Charter Contract") for the purposes of authorizing KANU O KA 'ĀINA NEW CENTURY PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL as a public charter school in the state of Hawaii; under its terms, the Charter Contract expires on June 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has not reviewed the Charter Contract for renewal which, if granted, would award a new contract to begin on July 01, 2021 (the "New Charter Contract"); and

WHEREAS, for reasons including closures due to COVID-19, the Commission and the School needed additional time to implement and participate in the renewal process possibly resulting in the award of a New Charter Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Commission on October 08, 2020, unanimously passed a Motion to Extend the current Charter Contract for one year to allow both the Commission and the School time to implement and participate in the renewal process; and

WHEREAS, the Commission has relocated from its former address, at 1111 Bishop Street, Suite 516, Honolulu, Hawaii, 96813, to its current address at 1164 Bishop Street, Suite 1100, Honolulu, Hawaii, 96813; and

**WHEREAS**, effective July 01, 2021, the parties agree to extend the July 1, 2017 Charter Contract and to the following changes set forth in this Amendment, it is hereby understood and agreed as follows,

### II. Amendments

#### Address Changes:

All reference in the July 01, 2017 Charter Contract, including the preamble and in any exhibits thereto of the principal place of business and mailing address of the State Public Charter School Commission shall be amended in their entirety and replaced with "1164 Bishop Street, Suite 1100, Honolulu, Hawaii, 96813."

#### Terms:

The following amendments are agreed to by the parties and added to the July 01, 2017 Charter Contract as follows, in replacement of the corresponding portion of each section or exhibit referenced below:

Section 2.3 Term: A one year extension of the July 01, 2017 Charter Contract signed by the parties June 30, 2017 and attached hereto, shall commence on July 01, 2021 and will terminate on June 30, 2022.

**Exhibit B Academic Performance Framework**: All of the targets for academic proficiency, academic growth, college and career readiness, and achievement gap set forth for KANU O KA 'ĀINA NEW CENTURY PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL for school year 2020-2021 shall apply to school year 2021-2022, and are as follows:

### 5. Additional Student Outcomes

Kanu o ka 'Āina implements the Renaissance STAR Math and Reading Assessments as an internal assessment for students in grades 2-12. Student STAR assessment data measures student growth; guides student and school goal setting; informs curriculum and instruction; and guides decisions about educational programs and resources.

### GOAL 1a & 1b:

60% of students in grades 2-12 will increase their STAR Math Pre to Post assessment SGP by 10% in SY17-18.

65% of students in grades 2-12 will increase their STAR Math Pre to Post assessment SGP by 10% in SY18-19.

## GOAL 2a & 2b:

70% of students in grades 2-12 will increase their STAR Reading Pre to Post assessment SPG by 10% in SY17-18.

75% of students in grades 2-12 will increase their STAR Reading Pre to Post assessment SPG by 10% in SY18-19.

This First Amendment to the KANU O KA 'ĀINA NEW CENTURY PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL July 01, 2017 Charter Contract, along with the attached original Charter Contract forms the entire agreement between the Parties.
